

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF MACKINAW

WHEREAS, the Village of Mackinaw owns the personal property that is described on the attached list which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Village of Mackinaw hereby determine that it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interest of the Village of Mackinaw to continue to own the property that is described on the attached list; and

WHEREAS, 65 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/11-76-4 authorizes the Village of Mackinaw to adopt an Ordinance allowing the sale of personal property.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MACKINAW AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Village Collector of the Village of Mackinaw is hereby authorized to sell the personal property that is described on the list which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference without advertising for sale in a manner and method as determined to be appropriate by the Village Collector after consultation with the Village President and Public Works Manager of the Village of Mackinaw.

SECTION TWO: All funds received from the sale of the foregoing items of personal property shall be deposited into the appropriate funds of the Village of Mackinaw.

SECTION THREE: The President and Clerk are hereby authorized, respectively, to execute and attest such documents as may be necessary to the conveyance herein authorized including but not limited to any Bill of Sale if requested from any purchaser.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance has been approved by a vote of at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of the corporate authorities now holding office as required by 65 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/11-76-4.
