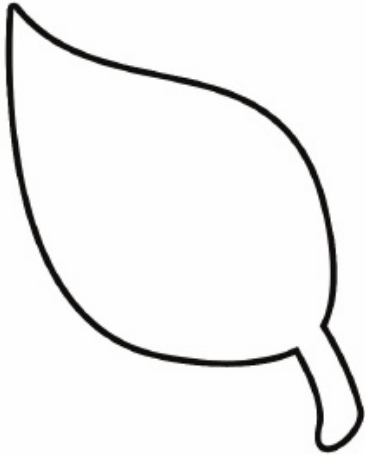


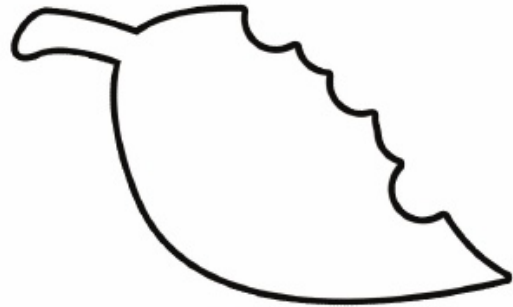
Life Cycle OF A Butterfly

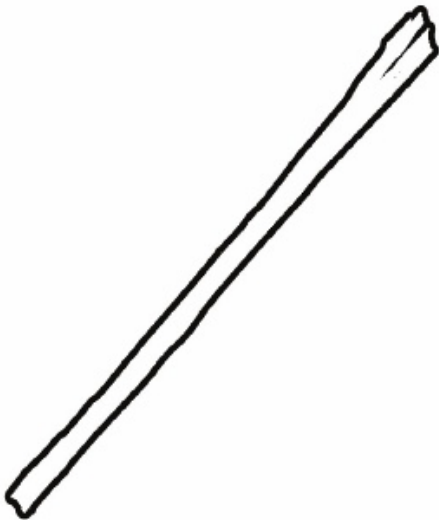
Egg
